#### **MAYOR OF MONASH GOLF DAY**

The 2015 Mayor of Monash Golf Day was held at Riversdale Golf Club on a balmy Tuesday October 20th. This year due to some changes made by the organising Committee we had a record number of players (132) which is a vast improvement on previous years. The result was more revenue received from sponsors.

Some great golf and networking endured with some excellent scores recorded. The current Mayor of Monash Councillor Paul Klisaris was very supportive of the event, entering a team as a sponsor and participating throughout the dinner auction as well. Our auction was the highlight with the introduction of a \$200 share for the purchase of a mobility scooter for CPEC students. We anticipated we would get at most 10 donors that would enable the purchase of 1 scooter. In fact we raised sufficient funds from this auction segment to purchase 4.5 scooters! Two participants purchased one each for \$2,000!

In total we raised over \$50,000 this year which is a record and more than \$20,000 better than last year. Obviously the Organising Committee consisting of Rotarians from Oakleigh, Glen Waverley, Waverley, Wheelers Hill and of course Mt Waverley were very pleased with the end result.

CPEC as the primary beneficiary will now be in a much stronger position to continue the fine work they are doing assisting disabled children to gain mobility.
