Bianca gave us an insight into the Foyer's background and operations providing accommodation and support services to 40 young students, between the ages of 16-24, for 2 years while they are studying and who unfortunately cannot live at home. The work the Foyer does in our Community is reflected in the passion and enthusiasm exhibited by each speaker who shares the belief that

young people really can be whatever they want to be, and the Foyer provides the framework to help them achieve their life goals. Our Club looks forward to working with the Education First Youth Foyer on joint projects whether they are mentoring, public speaking or just helping out with our Bunning's BBQ/s.




