PRESIDENTS REPORT (14 May 2014)

Last Wednesday I had the pleasure of inducting John Stathis as a new member of our Club. John has been attending our meetings for a while now and has also been helping "behind the scenes" at both the Mount Waverley and Oakleigh markets. If you haven't had a chance to meet and have chat with John yet, please do so and make him welcome.

John's induction was followed by not one, but two very interesting presentations. Baker IDI has been one of our community service donor

recipient's for some time and we were addressed by Baker IDI's Dr Andrew Siebel. Dr Siebel provided a very interesting insight into the effects of HDL and LDL – good and bad cholesterol, and how current research has moved away from Cardio vascular risk judgement's based on absolute cholesterol levels. Dr Siebel explained how we have levels of both good cholesterol and bad cholesterol, and he explained how each reacts in our system, and how we should seek the appropriate balance. The work carried out by Baker IDI is cutting edge and puts Australian heart disease and diabetes research up with the world's best.

Interestingly this presentation was followed by Paul Power's long promised talk about his heart attack whilst on holidays in China and the extraordinary experience of being attended to in Asian hospitals prior being flown back to Australia. A story with a happy ending but with take home messages about the value of good travel insurance, and how vulnerable we can be if we don't have at least a basic grasp of the language of the country we are visiting.

Rhonda and I attended the Last Cluster meeting and then the President' meeting for this Rotary year. It was an opportunity for Presidents Elect to meet, and to familiarise themselves with the communication process from RI via the District Governors to the clubs. Topics raised were the need to revise club constitutions (ours is done) a promotion for the International Convention – still time to register, and vacancies for RYLA. There is still time to nominate candidates for RYLA. This month I will be asking each of the Avenue of Service chairs to help me put together our usual Annual Report. PE Rhonda will also be overseeing the setting of the budget for 2014/15 in the next three weeks or so. Members are of course invited to put any proposals for inclusion in the budget; via the relevant chairperson in the first instance.

We need to get some budding musicians or buskers to work at our Mount Waverley market to add some atmosphere. If any of you have contacts for this please talk to Beth, Malcolm F or talk to me.
