This makes a great contribution from us to the Rotary Foundation and comes back to us a few years down the track.

Stephanie Christie from Waverley Eisteddfod acknowledged our club's long association with their event and invited the more Arts orientated members to contact her about helping their team in the future. The Russell-Salter Award is now presented to their premier event winner in an effort to assist the winner to develop their skills and talent further. Stephanie also presented the club with a Certificate of Appreciation which was well received by stand in President on the evening, Ron Thorpe.

Our main guest speaker, Myles Russell-Cook had many wondering what we were in for with his presentation. He certainly made us think and in some ways reassess our view of our history and attitude to reconciliation. He spoke factually and eloquently and answered the large number of questions very well. I always feel that the number of questions asked of the guest speaker is a reflection of the strength of their presentation. Perhaps the thing that resonated most with me was that until 1967 Aboriginals were classified under the Flora and Fauna Act. If you killed or injured an Aboriginal you were charged with animal cruelty. How alien is this concept to everything Rotary stands for? I remember watching Sid Jackson playing for Carlton in 1966, the then VFL actually treated him with more equality and fairness than the law. Myles presented facts, acknowledged that the Aboriginal people did also gain many benefits from colonialism and said we need to focus on preserving the many diverse cultures of a 50,000 year old civilization.

We all look forward to hearing from David Bloom as our guest speaker this week. Make sure you turn up and support him in his first public address to the club.
