#### **Presidents Report for 14 September 2016**



#### **BOARD DELIBERATIONS**

The following is a list of indigenous projects which will be considered by the Board:

1. Feed The Little Children program. Supported by the Broome Rotary Club WA.

Note: A Rotarian with the Broom W.A. Club, Padmini, will be a guest speaker at the Rotary Club of Box Hill on Tuesday 27 September. Cost is \$35. Notify David Tolstrup by Thursday Sept 22<sup>nd</sup> so that you can be booked in. 2. Wongutha Christian Aboriginal Parent-Directed School (CAPS) in Western Australian. Michael Jacobs (Trustee of the Len Cuzens Trust) outlines several projects to support the Wongutha Christian Aboriginal Parent-Directed School (CAPS) in Western Australian. Also it should be noted that for the first time ever a Wongutha CAPS student has been selected to go on Rotary Youth Exchange in 2017. Projects as follows:

- 1. Independent Living Units. Support for the provision of furniture for 2 independent living units. The total cost to fit these units is around \$20,000.
- 2. Connecting Boarding Houses up to Internet and School Computer Network. Satellite upgrade for the internet service at the school is being undertaken. Support is required to provide trench cabling from the school to the boarding houses to enabling student access the internet and school network for homework. The cost is estimated at \$21,579
- 3. School Trip Support for the whole school to take a trip to Sydney, Canberra and Melbourne. This is the first time for a trip of this magnitude in 17 years. The students and staff are contributing \$500 each to the trip, but will not completely cover the cost of the trip without drawing on school operational income. Any support for this trip is welcome.
- 4. Driver Training. A second driver training car has been obtained and support is required for funding of a full time driving instructor.
