Presidents Report for 21 February 2018.

Last week we had a good turnout of 19 members who came to listen to Marjo Angelico from the Waverley Historical Society.

Marjo described how Melbourne was originally laid out in a one mile grid pattern. With a number of arial photographs, Marjo described how the Mount Waverley area was developed, and how the location of the rail lines very largely determined the centre of each village. Photographs of just how the Wheelers Hill Hotel and surrounds have changed over the years was of particular interest as

were photographs of Hamilton place before and during the shopping centre development. Marjo's presentation was very well received and it drew many questions from the floor.
