#### Dear D9810 ROMAC Team,

All went well with the arrival of Fidelcia and her mother, Hernania, on Wed evening. Our interpreter, Lidia Soares, accompanied them to Liz Olie's home and they settled well into their new environment.

Yesterday was not as plain sailing. After a 9am start at RCH for her pre-admission clinic, it was determined that Fidelcia be admitted to hospital, which happened around 12.30pm. Over the previous 24 hours she had contracted a severe chest infection, bordering on pneumonia, which must be resolved before her heart surgery can be undertaken. She was admitted to Koala Ward, Room 324, where she was set up with IV medication and fluid, tubed for food and given oxygen. She was resting, and Hernania had settled into the hospital routine, by 6.30pm. Unfortunately, her breathing did not improve overnight and early this morning Fidelcia was moved to ICU as a precaution.

Liz Olie is with them today as we await news of Fidelcia's progress.

I will keep you informed as I know more.
