### PRESIDENTS REPORT (18 April for 23 April 2014)

I haven't heard much about last Wednesday except that once again Marilyn excelled herself as hostess. I look forward to getting feedback when I return. I have received a notice from District on the latest membership statistics. An extract of this message appears below.

#### "Membership Observations.

Reviewing the District 9810 membership numbers based on the results recently published, an initial glance at the bottom line shows that the District membership is up 17 year-to-date. So our District membership is stable we are not showing, based on these figures, any dramatic membership decline.

However we are also not showing any significant signs of a growth in membership despite the message, given out to the Club President's, of a RI key focus is that we grow our membership by 3%. Looking at the Club numbers in more detail shows that we have a significant number of Clubs that are reaching a critical level. The following table (Ed..table is not included) shows the picture in perspective with 54% of our Districts Clubs with 25 or less members."

I am more positive about these statistics given a prior declining trend. However this is one important item on the agenda for the upcoming District Assembly.

I am a fairly harsh judge of the value of some District Rotary meetings. However I can recommend the District Assembly as a well structured and worthwhile District Meeting. In fact I believe that it is very valuable for all Board members, Club Chairs and new members to attend if at all possible, and I am likely to remind you regularly of this upcoming event. 
