Dear D9810 ROMAC Team,

A lot has happened since my last update on 15 Jan. Suffice to say, that after many discussions between the doctors at MMC, RCH and internationally, and two further family meetings, Anton will have surgery on Mon to insert a Central Line in his neck and chemotherapy will be commenced on Tue.

Anton's condition has been more complicated than first thought. The cancer he has is rare and very aggressive. Whilst the tumour on his kidney was removed, and his brain, bone marrow and bone scans have been clear, his oncologist advises that the cancer will return and chemotherapy is required. However, it has been found that Anton's heart is severely damaged, and as he is also being treated for TB, Anton's situation is somewhat unique and much medical consultation has had to be undertaken to determine the best way forward. He will have two 3 week cycles of chemotherapy, after which his situation will be reassessed, particularly in regard to the effect of the chemotherapy on his heart.

Over the last few weeks Anton has been recovering well from his surgery and generally has been in fine fettle. He eats just about everything put in front of him and he has put on 3kg since the surgery. The hospital discharged him last Thursday and he is now home with Dianne and Bill Sides. He will come back to MMC for his chemotherapy for about 4-6 days then return home until the next cycle. Given that the chemotherapy will attack his immune system, he may have to return to MMC for treatment during the 3 week cycle, should he develop any infections.

The local Timorese community has been very active in visiting Anton and Claudina and they will be taking them to mass on Sunday. Other visitors are welcome also but please ring Dianne first and, if you are fighting off a cold, sniffle or any other infection, please delay your visit until you are well.

Some recent photos of Anton are attached. We now enter a new and critical phase of Anton's treatment and he will need all our thoughts and prayers to get him through.
