Dear 9810 Presidents,

The Victoria Police Mentoring Project will be commencing again shortly and nominations are now being sought from Rotarians to become mentors to senior sergeant police officers for a period of 12 months from October 2017.

For this year, we need a total of four Rotarians who live or work close to the following areas: Mount Martha, Mordialloc, Mont Albert or Parkdale. These areas have been specified by the officers who have been selected for the program.

This project was initiated by Victoria Police and is an exceptional Rotary Vocational Service project. It has support from the highest level of Victoria Police and is considered a critical part in the preparation of senior officers for their management role within the Force.

Two files are attached:

1. A flyer which announces the project with some brief details to generate interest; and

2. A Project Guidelines document that provides more in-depth details of the program and explains the nomination process.

It would be much appreciated if you could circulate the Flyer and Guidelines to members AND follow up with any members who express interest in the program.

In normal Rotary fashion, a little encouragement/pressure can work wonders - nearly every Club would have members that would make excellent mentors in this program.


Bicycles for Humanity, another Rotary project, which send bikes to needy people in Africa have contacted Yvonne as well. They only send adult bikes to Africa and have offered to pass on the many children's bikes they receive to Yvonne's project. WooHoo!!! They have also invited Yvonne to travel with them to Namibia next year to see how they go about their distribution process. This is something Yvonne is seriously looking at doing. She has been to Africa many times, as her sister lives on a farm in South Africa. The seed for the Butterfly project was planted in her mind there when she saw the sheer joy and pride of a young South African farm worker when he was given a beaten up old bike. It was the best thing he ever had and changed his life.

Yvonne was nominated and is now a finalist for the Australasian Council of Women and Policing Awards, which are being held in Cairns in September. She has been invited there and will participate in the International Women and Law Enforcement Conference being held at the same time. She's certainly had a big year and attributes no small part to the things she's learned in this Rotary/VicPol program.

The VicPol Leadership Mentoring Program is now looking for mentors for the 2017/18 intake. I urge all club members to get involved as the experience has been great for me as a mentor. Yvonne and I have decided to continue our meetings even though the program is coming to an end. She would also like to come to our club as a guest speaker after September to talk about the Butterfly project.
