Presidents Report for 7 February 2018.

He also mentioned his exposure to Rotary through his parent's involvement both in the Philippines and here in Australia with the RC's of East Malvern and Donvale. Giovanni has been a Rotaractor and a RYLA graduate having attended the programme in 2013.

This is a significant Australian Community project and we as a Club will be placing our full support behind the project. I have taken an excerpt from a previous email received from our District Governor, Malcolm Chiverton, which gives some background: -

'In February 2018, a series of short Facebook Live Videos will be conducted with specialist speakers from around the world, including RI President Ian Riseley, giving context to the trachoma problem in Australia and what Rotary is doing to address it. Most importantly, the Facebook Videos will outline service opportunities for Rotarians and Clubs in your District. The videos are currently scheduled to start on Monday 19 February 2018 at 5 pm AEDT and will continue daily for 7 days. Each episode is expected to last around 10 minutes'. Please take time to have a look at the videos.

How great would it be if every Rotarian in D9810 fully understood the situation with Trachoma, and joined us on this journey to elimination! With your help, this becomes possible!


