Funded by a grant from The Rotary Foundation, the new school has met with tremendous success, providing an education to youth from the Wakka Wakka Aboriginal people. Students are required to attend school from Monday – Thursday, learning basic education and tending a herd of beef cattle. When the students graduate, they leave with strong academic knowledge as well as viable farming skills.
