President's Report 10 July 2013



After last week's changeover night, it was somewhat quieter last night, but a good opportunity as usual to have a social chat.

We also discussed a couple of ideas I have about the Club's direction over the next twelve months. For the benefit of those not present, I will some of the points from last night.

I would like to work with Don to see if it is feasible to offer any Rotary programmes for younger people, perhaps early Secondary students.

This provides backup for those chairpersons who want a break, want to travel, etc. We are fortunate with so many new members coming on board that we can match their interests with the positions that would benefit from having an understudy.

We have "dipped our toes in the water" with social networking, and we have our own Facebook page. We need to understand how best to use social networking tools for the benefit of the Club. Understandably, many members have privacy concerns generally with social networking, and your Board will need to be mindful of this when coming up with a strategy.

Last night I summarized the Club Leadership Plan and offered a list of task and responsibilities for each member. I have spoken to most of you about what I have listed, but I emphasise that I want members to be comfortable with the list, so talk to me if your interests are in a different area.
