PRESIDENTS REPORT 26 FEB 2014

I had met David only once, so did not know him, but his contribution in Rotary at various levels was quite substantial. Past RI President Royce Abby also passed away this week.

Honorary member and Charter member of our club, Geoffrey Blackburn and Jessie have moved to a retirement village in Donvale and are both well. I couldn't speak to Geoff as he was having "forty winks" after recovering from a throat problem. He is to ring me when he feels better. I hope that he can join us for our club's 29th anniversary.

The District Assembly will be held this year on 18th May. It is particularly valuable for incoming Avenue of Service chairs and Board members, and new members will also get a lot of information about Rotary at this assembly. One for the diary.



BLAZE AID

Volunteers needed for important bushfire recovery

Blaze Aid is a volunteer organisation that is helping farming communities to recover after bushfires and floods. It started after the devastation of the Black Saturday bushfires in 2009.

Blaze Aid needs volunteers of all ages and abilities. Being a Blaze Aid volunteer is easy. Fencing experience is not required, just a willingness to give it a go, and enjoy being with likeminded people willing to lend a hand. There are a variety of jobs other than fencing – not all jobs are physically demanding.

Volunteers need to bring their own tents, camper trailers or caravans, as well as suitable work clothes and footwear. All meals, fluoro vests, safety items, tools and equipment are provided.

The farmer provides all the replacement wire, posts and gates.

An important part of volunteering with Blaze Aid is providing support and friendship. It is giving the farmer and his family the first sign of hope and recovery from the traumatic loss and damage they have suffered.
